"Maybe you could pick a rose for me," she said.




不幸的是, 货物还没卖出去就被强盗抢走了, 商人只 能两手空空地往家走。

商人吓坏了,他跪在地上恳求野兽的原谅。他告诉野兽, 他的三个女儿不能没有爸爸。


野兽想了想,说:"我给你三天时间,你可以回去跟你的女儿们道别。如果你的一个女儿愿意代替你死,我就饶了你。"

这天晚上, 贝儿梦见野兽一动不动地躺在 花园的草地上, 就快要死了。


